Kindergarten Through 2nd Grade Music

- Learn about the basics of music through singing, dancing, playing instruments, composing, playing music games, etc.
- Students have the opportunity to play simple percussion instruments such as drums and rhythm sticks
- Students get general music from 70 to 105 minutes a week

3rd and 4th Grade Music

- Students build on their knowledge of basic musical concepts to explore more complex musical ideas and make connections outside the classroom
- 3rd and 4th grade students will have the opportunity to play recorders this year!
- Students get general music for 70 minutes or more per week.
